It is a great pleasure to welcome Nasstassia Hylton back to Highclare School.

Miss Nasstassia Hylton: Miss Hylton is a practising barrister specialising in family law. She is an ex-pupil of Highclare School – a member of Lancaster House – who left in 2001 as Head Girl. She went on to study law and politics at the University of Manchester, followed by undertaking her legal training at Nottingham Law School. She also has a Masters in Law. Miss Hylton is an established and highly respected barrister with a practice that covers all areas of family law, having worked in London for the past 13 years. She is ranked as a leading barrister in Chambers and Partners. She provides training services, contributes to an online legal resource and is a co-author of a book on legal self-representation. Miss Hylton is married and she has 2 young daughters. When time allows she enjoys art, running and the theatre.

Mrs Angela Moore: Mrs Moore joined Highclare School in September 2006 and completed 15 years of dedicated service to the Senior School, firstly as an English teacher and then taking on a school-wide pastoral role before becoming, for the last nine years, Head of Senior School.
