Uniform: Pre-Prep – Cygnets and Swans

1. Compulsory Regulation Items – available from school uniform suppliers

- a. Regulation (badged) navy blue top and trousers (this is also worn for PE in Swans)
- b. Regulation white polo shirt (with school badge)
- c. Regulation unisex black reversible waterproof coat/fleece (with school badge)
- d. Regulation unisex blue shorts
- e. Regulation black drawstring bag (with school badge)
- f. Regulation black book bag (with school badge)
- g. Regulation black rucksack (with school badge)

2. Optional Regulation Items – available from school uniform suppliers (no other items are allowed)

- a. Regulation grey beanie hat to wear in playground / severe weather
- b. Regulation school scarf
- c. Regulation navy Highclare sun hat

3. Non- Regulation Items – available from High Street stores

- a. Plain navy blue cagoule, waterproof trousers and wellingtons to be kept in school for outside play on wet days.
- b. Short white ankle socks
- c. Black plimsolls for indoor PE
- d. Plain black shoes (no decorations) or plain black or white trainers
- e. Gloves (plain grey or black)

4. Appearance - High standards of appearance and conduct are required at all times.

- a. Hair – Hair must be clean, tidy and a natural colour. Hair should be arranged tidily in a conventional style. Hair ties should be small and plain in black. Hair bands should be plain and inconspicuous – no flowers or other adornments permitted. Please note that braided hair is only allowed for two weeks, following a holiday. *No beads allowed.* Hair accessories are available from John Lewis
- b. Nails - No nail polish.
- c. Jewellery - No jewellery, apart from one pair of plain gold ear studs, is allowed

A complete spare set of regulation uniform should be sent into school and be kept in the drawstring bag on your child's peg at all times.
