**e. Optional Regulation items (i.e. No other item is acceptable)**

- i. Regulation School scarf
- ii. Regulation grey beanie hat to wear in playground or severe weather
- iii. Regulation navy hooded top - *for trips and activities*
- iv. Regulation black swimming bag **(Yr3-6)**
- vii. Regulation white / red PE / polo shirt (with school badge) **Yr1-Yr6**

**2. Non- Regulation Items – available from High Street stores**

**a. Compulsory Non-Regulation items**

- i. Black knee length socks or plain, thick black tights, no flesh coloured tights are permitted in the Preparatory School.
- ii. White ankle socks (with no logos) for summer term. *NB: Trainer socks are not permitted.*
- iii. Plain black shoes. These should not be black trainers nor trainers sold on the high street as shoes.
- iv. Two pairs of plain black or white trainers for outdoor PE and indoor PE
- v. Shin pads
- vi. Art overall (or old shirt)
- vii. White ankle sports socks for Reception only
- viii. Gum shield **(Year 3 – Year 6)**

**b. Optional Non-Regulation items**

- i. Gloves (plain grey or black)
- ii. Navy base layers for PE / Games (Year 3 – 6 only)

**3. Appearance - High standards of appearance and conduct are required at all times.**

- a. Watches - If watches are worn, please make them suitable for school use in muted colours. No smart watches are allowed.
- b. Jewellery – no jewellery, apart from one small pair of plain gold/silver ear studs, are allowed which must be covered by swimming hats for swimming or taped over with micropore tape for PE
- c. Make up – No make-up, nail polish or nail extensions are allowed.
- d. Hair – Hair must be clean, tidy and a natural colour. Hair should be arranged tidily in a conventional style. Hair ties should be small and plain in black, brown, navy or burgandy. Hair bands should be plain and inconspicuous – no flowers or other adornments permitted.
