Uniform: Senior Girls U3 to U5

1. Regulation items – available from school uniform suppliers

a. Compulsory Regulation Items (U3 to U5):

- i. Regulation unisex black reversible waterproof coat/fleece (with school badge) or a plain black coat (NB: no logos, fur trim or extreme styles)
- ii. Regulation grey wool blazer (with red piping)
- iii. Regulation grey / red / black check skirt (NB: no shorter than 6cm above knee, measured when kneeling)
- iv. Regulation black V-necked sweater or sleeveless pullover with red stripes on neckline (embroidered in house colour)
- v. Regulation white open-neck blouse (3/4 or short sleeved), to be worn with a plain white or 'neutral' skin toned bra (not dark or brightly coloured which may be visible beneath)
- vi. Regulation black school bag (with school badge)

b. Compulsory Regulation PE kit (U3 to U5)

- i. Regulation PE bag for sports equipment (with school badge)
- ii. Regulation white polo shirt
- iii. Regulation white/cherry athletics vest (optional)
- iv. Regulation cherry games skort
- v. Regulation navy tracksuit
- vi. Regulation navy hoodie
- vii. Regulation navy/cherry games socks and shin pads
- viii. Regulation white (with red stripe) socks for athletics and netball

c. Optional Regulation items (i.e. No other item is acceptable)

- i. Regulation School scarf
- ii. Regulation grey beanie hat to wear in playground or severe weather
- iii. Regulation white/cherry athletics vest (optional)
- iv. Regulation cherry games shorts (optional)

2. Non- Regulation Items – available from High Street stores

a. Compulsory Non-Regulation items (U3 to U5)

- i. Black knee length socks (not over the knee), plain, thick black tights or tan tights (15/20 denier).
- ii. Plain black shoes (maximum heel height 6cms with heel base not less than 2 cms). These should not be black trainers nor trainers sold on the high street as shoes.
- iii. Art overall (or old shirt)
- iv. Trainers

b. Compulsory Non-Regulation items (U3 to U4 only)

- i. White, craft-style cookery apron for food and nutrition
- ii. Cookery bag (available from School) or cookery basket
- iii. One-piece swim suit in a plain colour and style (U3 and L4 only)

c. Optional Non-Regulation items (U3 to U5)

- i. Gloves (plain grey or black)
- ii. White base layers for PE / Games
- iii. Any religious head coverings should be in school colours

3. Appearance - High standards of appearance and conduct are required at all times.

- i. Make up - No make- up, fake tan, nail polish or nail extensions are allowed
- ii. Jewellery – no jewellery, apart from one small pair of plain ear studs, are allowed.
- iii. Hair – Hair must be clean, tidy and a natural colour (we will NOT accept unnatural, excessive or extreme changes in colour). Hair should be arranged tidily in a conventional style. For safety and practicality, long hair should be tied back and hair ties / hair bands should be small and plain in grey, black, maroon or muted colours. No fancy hair slides or decorations. Beaded braided hair is only allowed for a maximum of two weeks, following a holiday. Shaven heads, or hair cut so that the head, or part(s) of it appear to have been shaven are not allowed (eg: no tramlines and Mohican styles).
