

Job Description: Sports and PE Coach

School Aims:

- To provide high quality teaching and to encourage independent learning and individual excellence within a secure and happy environment.
- To motivate each learner to achieve his / her full all round potential.
- To develop the value of self-respect and self-discipline, alongside tolerance and respect for others and the environment

Duties

- 1. To support the Head of PE and PE staff in delivering high-quality physical education across the Preparatory Schools..
- 2. To coach a variety of sports.
- 3. To ensure that all PE activities are carried out in a safe environment and in accordance with health and safety guidelines.
- 4. To make a contribution to the development of the level and amount of fixtures played and help to raise the profile of sport.
- 5. To assit the Head of PE with fixture / tournament preparation against other schools from: team selection, liaising with the transport manager and catering manager and ensuring all relevant medical issues have been addressed.
- 6. To provide all pupils with an environment to develop and achieve, whatever their ability.
- 7. To actively support the wider sporting and co-curricular programme, including after-school clubs, sports days and school trips.
- 8. To engage in relevant professional development to maintain and enhance subject knowledge and coaching practice.
- 9. To participate in the school's appraisal system and take direction from the Head of PE and Senior Leadership Team as appropriate.
- 10. To contribute to the assessment, recording and reporting of pupils' progress in PE as required.
- 11. To maintain good communication links via email, telephone and in person where appropriate.
- 12. To be available to team teach and cover if and when necessary.
- 13. To be a supportive and reliable member of staff within the department and school as a whole.
- 14. To be a professional representative of Highclare School at all times.
- 15. To uphold the school's safeguarding policies and ensure the welfare and safety of all pupils in their care.
